THE FOLLOWING COURSES ARE CONSIDERED TO BE EQUIVALENT OR PROVIDE AN ALTERNATIVE TO THE STANDARD OF THE IRSE PROFESSIONAL EXAMINATION

1. The Indian Railways Secunderabad – Gazetted Officers Course in Signalling

Membership applicants who have passed the Indian Railways Secunderabad course(s) in signalling and have gained a pass in IRSE professional examination Module 1, Safety of Railway Signalling and Communications, will be considered to have an exemption from taking the full IRSE Examination.

2. The Graduate Diploma/Certificate in Railway Signalling offered through Central Queensland University, Australia

The level of a Distinction in the CQU Graduate Diploma/Certificate in Railway Signalling is considered equivalent to a Pass in the IRSE professional examination and membership candidates with this qualification will be accepted as having an exemption from taking the IRSE examination.

The level of a Pass or Credit in the CQU Graduate Diploma in railway signalling, when coupled with relevant professional experience, is considered to provide an appropriate equivalent qualification for a candidate to offer for IRSE membership. (Byelaw 2.6 refers)
